Governance Model

Recuperar Portugal is a mission structure (*task-force*) that is in charge of:

- Negotiating and monitoring the execution of the Portuguese RRP
- Monitoring the implementation of the Portuguese RRP reforms and investments
- Preparing and submitting to the European Commission requests for payments and collecting the necessary information from the competent authorities
- Implementing an Internal Control System of the Portuguese RRP
- Adopting effective and proportionate anti-fraud measures, considering the identified risks
- ✓ Signing contracts with the implementing bodies of the implementation of the reforms and investments and the corresponding milestones and targets









Implementation Agents and Process

DIRECT BENEFICIARIES (implementing body)

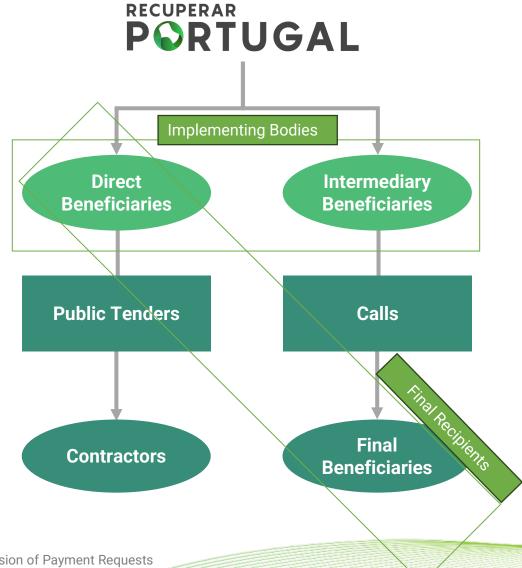
Public entities responsible for implementation of a RRP reform or investment, including its physical and financial execution. To that effect, they receive financing from Recuperar Portugal.

INTERMEDIARY BENEFICIARIES (implementing body)

Public entities responsible for implementation of a RRP reform or investment, through the selection of third-party entities for its execution, the Final Beneficiaries.

FINAL BENEFICIARIES

Public or Private entity responsible for the physical and financial execution of an RRP project, selected by an Intermediary Beneficiary. To that effect, they receive financing from their Intermediary Beneficiary.









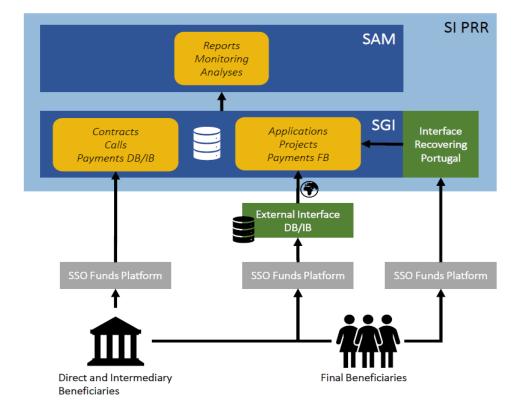




IT systems - SIPRR - SAM

- The Taskforce "Recuperar Portugal" contracts the investments and reforms to Direct and Intermediary Beneficiaries
- The Direct and Intermediary Beneficiaries become responsible for reporting the progress on the achievement of milestones and targets, final beneficiaries and projects, as well as financial and controlling information.
- That information is gathered and uploaded into the Information Management System (SGI) which is a part of the SIPRR.

The RRP Information System (SIPRR) consists of a Information Management System (SGI), a Monitoring and Follow-Up System (SAM) and interface with the Beneficiaries.





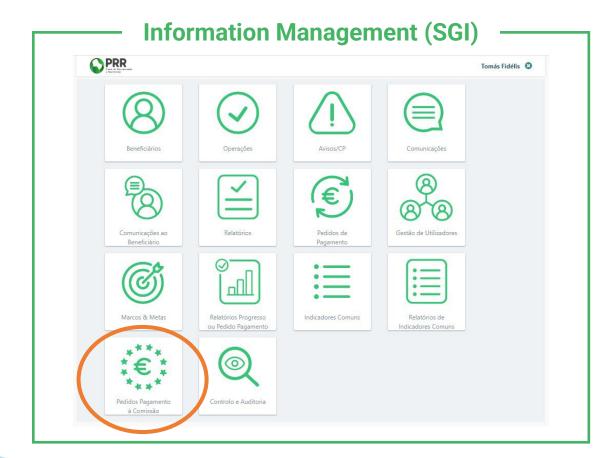


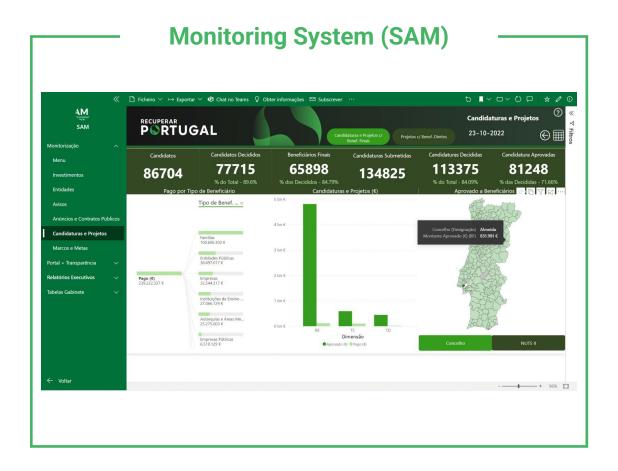

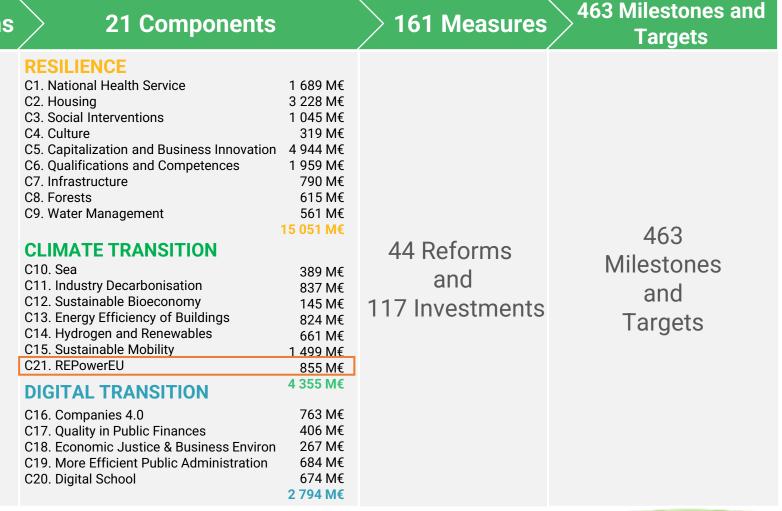
Portuguese RRP Overview - Updated

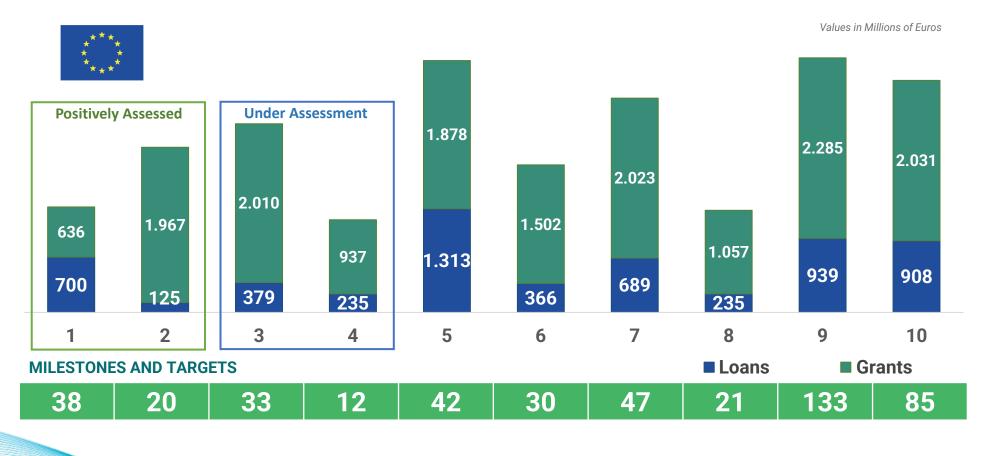






European Union Payments Profile

The execution of the RRP is measured through the achievement of milestones and targets and submitted in payment requests to the European Union, so that Portugal receives the amounts agreed with the EU.

Requirements for Payment Request Submission

EUROPEAN

- ➤ Request for payment in relation to the respective instalment up to the maximum amount set out in the Council Implementing Decision.
- ➤ Cover notes for all associated milestones and targets providing justification of the satisfactory fulfilment of the relevant milestones and targets.
- ► **Evidence** for all associated milestones and targets demonstrating the total costs carried to achieve the milestones and targets.
- ► Management Declaration declaring i) the funds were used for its intended purpose, ii) the information submitted is complete, accurate and reliable, iii) the control systems ensure the funds were managed in accordance with all applicable rules.
- ➤ **Summary of audits** including weaknesses identified and any corrective actions taken.

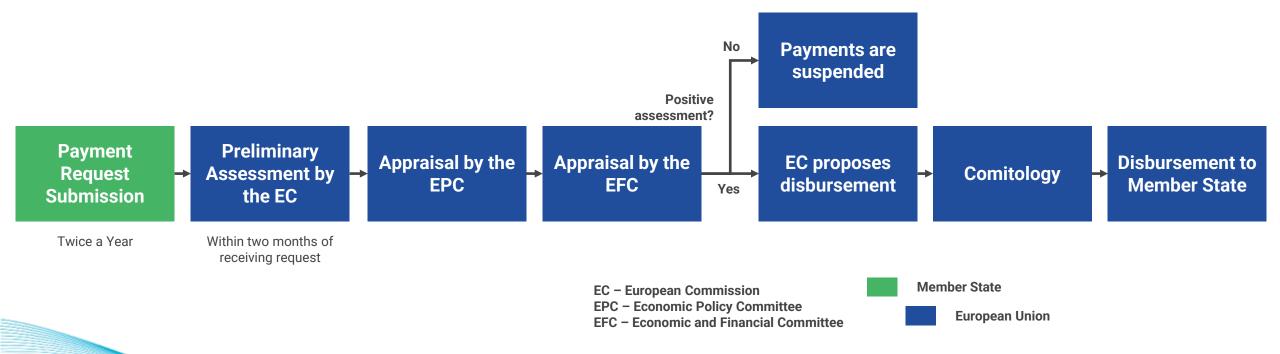




Formal Steps until Disbursement

As provided for in Article 24 of the Regulation (EU) 2021/241 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 February 2021 establishing the Recovery and Resilience Facility, as well as Article 6 of the Recovery and Resilience Facility Agreement between the Commission and the Portuguese Republic, the process until disbursement is as follows:

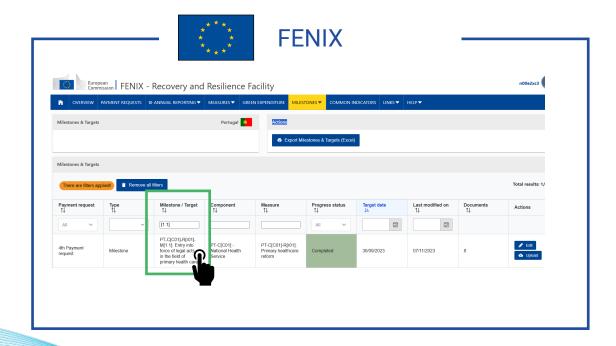

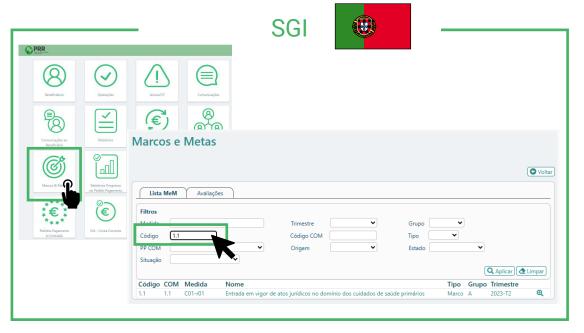

When developing the national RRP internal management and control system we have tried to replicate the FENIX Portal fields. The information is uploaded into the SGI and then manually submitted in FENIX.













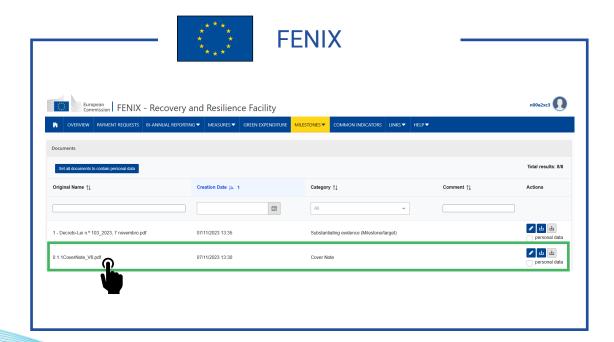
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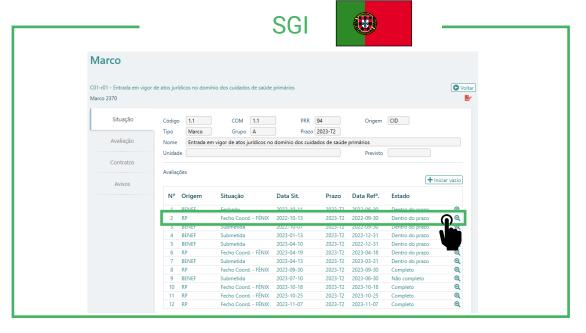

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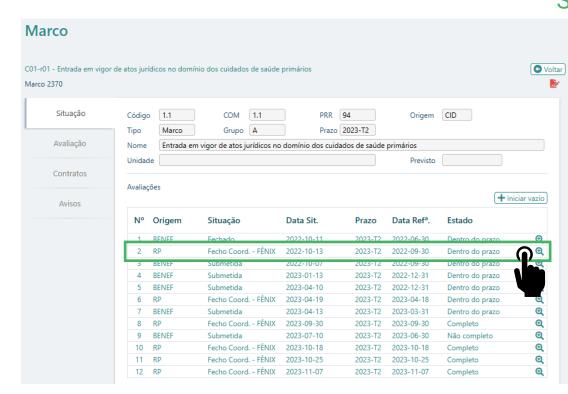

SGI

- Similar interface for the implementing bodies and the Coordinating body to ensure alignment of requirements and easy validation and conversion
- High number of iterations on Cover Notes and evidences with the European Commission registered in the system
- All sampling registered also in the system
- In development new FENIX folder structure for easier evidence uploading

Cover Notes

- Measure [text]
- Milestone/Target [text, including verification mechanism from the Operational Arrangement]
- Evidence [list]
 - Numbered, with the same numbering of the files to be submitted via FENIX
 - For evidences with many files, all are sub-numbered (e.g. 1.1, 1.2)
- **Detailed Justification**
 - Short introduction to contextualise to the measure and the milestone or target
 - Justification should provide explanation to every assertion of the measure text and the milestone/target text
 - Justifications should refer to the relevant evidence number, including page number of documents or other details to make verification easier
- ▶ **Date of Completion** of Milestone or Target

Cover Notes

Some Lessons Learned

- Initiating work on Cover Notes months in advance helps clear up interpretation differences and highlight missed requirements from the CID
- Pre-filled Cover Notes work better than blank ones for the implementing bodies. In some cases this means also preparing a table that requires justification for each CID sentence
- To avoid too many iterations in FENIX, Cover Notes and evidence are usually "informally stabilised" with the Commission before submitting in FENIX

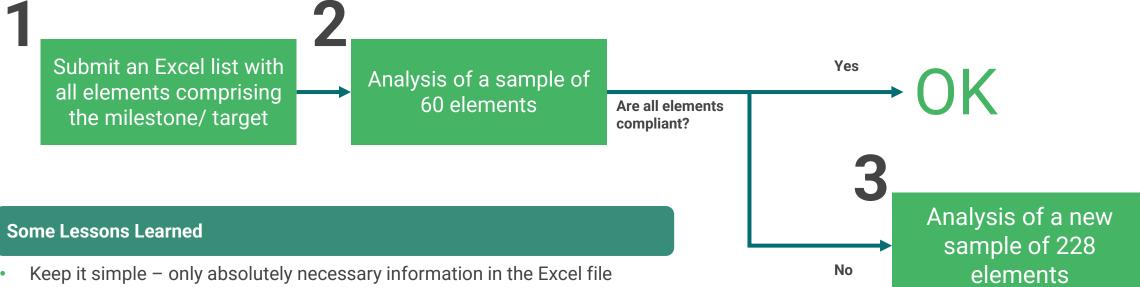
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Sampling
